Grant request for \$1228 was submitted for lodging for track as they attend a summit in Bend. They have funded themselves for past years. They are using Blast Fundraising and are hoping to raise \$6000, they are at \$5000.

Grant request for \$1350 submitted by Rugby for warm-ups, separate small grant request for \$350 to replace a stolen med kit, they are required to provide their own.

Stadium grant request submitted by administration and using Field of Dreams account. \$3500 for amp for PA system in stadium stands. Recommended components include: New mics to comply with regulations around frequency \$1500+; Equalizer to "do it right" \$2000; Screen for back of grand stands \$2700; Long Jump covers w/logo \$3000-\$4000 total comes to \$12,000 and empties Field of Dreams account.

Crab Feed: Raised \$72,000 gross/\$58,595.30 net. Paddle Raise funded fully after donation from Early Bird Rotary. We discuss ways to get a steeper discount on renting the Cultural Center

Concessions: April 5th Track meet is discussed. Are they getting volunteers for this event? Is it possible to get padlocks for concessions to illuminate people with keys "helping themselves" to items? Baseball Concessions is now being run by us, and not by baseball. VIP program is benefitting some groups who run it when it is not scheduled to be run by Boosters. It was helpful for Mr. Burke to assign teams like for winter sports. We could use for this to be an on-going thing.

Dormer's: The partnership is going well.

STEM: Robotics placed 11/32 at State Tournament. Hopefully there will be a Robotics class added and having a consistent school-based leader would be helpful.

Performing Arts: Chipotle Fundraiser on Saturday, March 23rd, Shakespeare play **Caesar** April 18-20 and 25-27 at 7:00. Band, Orchestra and Choir are entering their competition seasons.

Grad Night: The web-site is up and running. Docu-sign Registration will be up as of 3/23. April 5th is a Krispy Kreme fundraiser. A Dine-in is in the works. The secretary stepped down for this year, in May the annual meeting to elect officers for the 2019-20 year will be held.
