Total cost \$2,693; Funding from outside donor \$600; funding from NHS/District \$500. Balance requested from Boosters is \$1,593.

Kay Sunnes; Small grant requested for Orchestra for new music sheets. Total small grant request is for \$493.95. Music sheets are kept on hand for future use. Kristen asked how Orchestra is affiliated with Performing Arts as far as keeping requests separate (band, choir, theatre).
