Senior Night Request - I am writing to request a grant under the benevolence fund for the Newberg Grad Night this June. While we have raised a good bit of money, there is still some road to go before we get to the finish line. We are writing to request $\$ 1000$ to fund admission for more than 30 seniors to attend Grad Night. To date, we have raised about \$19,000. Our total budget is about $\$ 32,000$. After accounting for admission fees of $\$ 30$ per student, there is still a gap we need to cover of about $\$ 5000$. While we expect to get that from last minute donations, there is never a guarantee so we are reaching out to request some help to cover the admission fees for those students who cannot afford it otherwise. We would need the funds by June 8th, but would appreciate the decision sooner.

Boosters would grant up to $\$ 1000$ to go to Grad night for benevolence scholarships only and we would need the number to be reported back to boosters byJun 6, 2023Hannah motions Kay seconded, Jen will communicate with Grad Night
