- **Project Coordinator (Robby Mason)-
Softball**
 - Softball Backstop project- Both JV and Varsity backstops replaced and finished.
 - Upgrades include premium netting, Heavy gage chain link on both fields for longevity. (Will possibly need to replace the older upper area of the backstop netting next year).
 - Softball concession stand remodel – Some donated materials have been delivered, Looking for a siding supplier for donation of materials and a paint supplier... Could use some help with finding more volunteers in their program to help gain more interest/traction on these projects.
 - Softball landscaping – Delivered red rock for areas around arborvitaes and dugouts. Have let the coach know we have more available if they want/need it.

- Baseball**
 - Varsity Field Backstop renovation completed
 - Upgrades include new black chain link backstop, full netting over dugouts and new poles with 38 ft height to protect parking lot.
 - Volunteer accomplishments – Installed a landscaped tiered spectator viewing area, Painted both home and away dugouts, Replaced red cinder along backstop and dugout areas.

- District project**
 - Replaced old eastside student parking area fencing and gate with black chain link.

Overview – Completed both Softball and baseball backstop upgrades/renovations before spring season games started. Original backstop project bid from Benyon Sports Company was \$357K and we were able to get the entire project done for roughly \$65K (Big win). Also able to complete several volunteer driven improvements/efforts as well.
