



Committee & Leadership Volunteer Opportunities

You are needed! Newberg Boosters is the parent group for all the students at Newberg High School. No matter the activity, Boosters is there to help them succeed! We're a fun group of parents who enjoy working together to support our Newberg High School students. Please consider becoming a part of our team. Go Tigers!

Apparel Committee

The Apparel Committee works with Dormers Embroidery to help select and stock the apparel locker as well as communicate special spirit wear days to Dormers. You'll also organize volunteers for merchandise sales, manage locker inventory, and be responsible for communicating with the Treasurer to establish new items in Square. This team manages sales and delivery of online apparel offerings.

Auction Committee

The Auction Committee is a team that helps organize the annual auction and dinner for the community. You'll help coordinate the meal and beverage service, advertise the event, sell tickets, procure donations from the community, coordinate entertainment and decorate the venue.

Communications Committee

The Communications Committee is responsible for spreading the word about our activities, events and programs using a variety of platforms. You'll keep our website current, manage our email distribution list and our social networking sites, as well as draft and distribute announcements and flyers.

Concessions Committee

It takes a team effort to pull everything together in concessions. Please consider joining this very important committee in one of the following positions:

Team Leader

Open/Close the concession stand and act as shift supervisor.

Scheduling

Work with the Athletic Director to draft a master schedule of concessions events for each season and determine the manpower requirements for each event. Distribute the schedule to Team Leaders and Team Liaisons and work with Team Liaisons to recruit workers.

Purchasing

Check inventory and place orders or shop for supplies and stock concession stand. Coordinate with representative for soft drink orders.

Concessions Volunteer

Work in the concession stand preparing and selling snacks during home sporting events. To get on the concessions email list, send an email to NewbergHighBoosterClub@gmail.com. You will be informed of the concession needs coming up.

Fundraising Committee

The Fundraising Committee organizes fundraising activities such as Banner Sales, Corporate Sponsorships, and Program Advertisements. You'll work with parents to identify opportunities for matching grants or special fundraising opportunities available through their employers or other community groups. All funds raised are directed back into NHS programs to support all our students through grant requests and scholarships.

Golf Tournament Committee

The Golf Tournament Committee is responsible for organizing the annual Golf Tournament. You'll make arrangements with a venue, sell tickets, coordinate breakfast and lunch as well as alternative entertainment.

Nominating Committee

The Nominating Committee prepares and submits a list of names of people who are willing to serve as officers for Newberg Boosters. You'll select at least one nominee for each office to be filled, but consent of each candidate must be obtained before his or her name is placed in nomination. Additional nominations may be made from the floor at the election meeting, provided that consent from each candidate has been obtained before the name is placed in nomination. If practical, the nominee for President shall have served on the Executive Committee during the previous year.

Scholarship Committee

The Scholarship Committee is responsible for reviewing potential scholarship recipients per established guidelines and selecting those that will be awarded scholarship money from Newberg Boosters. The Scholarship Committee is appointed by the Executive Committee by the April meeting. The Scholarship Committee consists of four or five Newberg Booster members who are non-senior parents.

Special Events Committee

The Special Events Committee coordinates with Boosters, student groups, teams, faculty, parents and the community to present, host or co-host spirit events such as Tailgates, Stuff the Gym, Bonfire, and Rally Buses as well as educational presentations and outreach programs where students help in the community.

Leadership Team/Executive Officers

President

Supervise the business of the Boosters and preside at all Executive Committee meetings.

President-Elect

Supervise committee activities and support the efforts of the Executive Committee.

Vice President

Supervise and coordinate concession team activities including training of team leaders and volunteers and coordination of concession sub-committees.

Secretary

Keep the minutes and records of all Booster meetings. Maintain general email inbox communication by distributing emails to person responsible.

Treasurer

Receive all monies, keep financial records and make payments for Booster business. Prepare and present financial statements at meetings.

Team Liaisons

Each NHS athletic team needs to have a parent that acts as the link between Boosters and the team. Ideally, the Team Liaison should be able to attend the first 30 minutes of each monthly Booster meeting to learn what is going on with the school's athletic program and share ideas about how Boosters can help these programs. Team Liaisons may also be responsible for presenting grants requests for equipment, supplies and team expenses on behalf of your team.

Volunteer Coordinator

Help recruit volunteers and match them to opportunities to help with Booster activities and events. Recruit Team Liaisons and help connect parents with Booster activities.
